A mandala is a symbol of the universe in its ideal form, and its creation signifies the transformation of a universe of suffering into one of joy.

With this exhibition, photographer and artist Jeannette Handler wants to express her own connection between her inner world and the outer reality.

After shooting her series 'Graffiti' in the streets of Miami in the Wynwood district, her artistic style became more abstract. She digitally manipulates her photographs of flowers and nature until she creates images with vivid colours and layers of pure energy. The mandala series has to have a calming and healing effect on the viewers. When creating a Mandala, Buddhist monks want to represent the world and universe, they aim at creating harmony and symbolise concepts such as impermanence, wisdom, compassion, inner peace and love. After a difficult period of her life, Jeannette found peace and happiness again, creating the Mandala series.

For Handler, these photographs represent her own meditation and self-reflection, they are a deep dialogue with her own soul.

Jeannette Handler is a former advertising and fashion photographer, who has worked in Vienna and Milan.

Handler experiments in her work with the whole range of technical possibilities of present-day photography. Studies of nature, as well as impressions drawn from everyday life and traveling, are digitally reworked and in this way de-familiarised as far as both colour and motif are concerned.

The present exhibition offers a comprehensive insight into her artistic work over the past few years and allows the viewer to undertake a journey into the world of the artist's imagination.

Jeannette has published several photography books and has exhibited her work internationally.
